PAPER I: ENGLISH

Qualifying Paper in English will be of Matriculation or equivalent standard. Questions of the standard of SSC / Matriculation seeking to ascertain the Candidate's knowledge and language skills will be asked

PART-A: (OBJECTIVE TYPE) (50 QUESTIONS – 25 MARKS – 45 MINUTES)

Usage, Vocabulary, Grammar, Comprehension and other language skills in the Multiple Choice Questions Format (with ¼th (25%) negative marks for wrong answers)

PART-B: (DESCRIPTIVE TYPE) (75 MARKS – 2 HOURS 15 MINUTES)

Descriptive Type Questions covering Writing of Precis, Letters / Reports, Essay, Topical Paragraphs and Reading Comprehension

PAPER II: TELUGU / URDU

Candidates have to choose one of the languages i.e., either Telugu or Urdu and should indicate their choice as and when asked for by the recruiting authority. Option once exercised will be final and a candidate will not be allowed to change it subsequently

Qualifying Paper in Telugu or Urdu will be of Matriculation or equivalent standard. Questions of the standard of SSC / Matriculation seeking to ascertain the Candidate's knowledge and language skills will be asked

PART-A: (OBJECTIVE TYPE) (50 QUESTIONS – 25 MARKS – 45 MINUTES)

Usage, Vocabulary, Grammar, Comprehension and other language skills in the Multiple Choice Questions Format (with ¼th (25%) negative marks for wrong answers)

PART-B: (DESCRIPTIVE TYPE) (75 MARKS – 2 HOURS 15 MINUTES)
